

# Bask in the glory of top river views

WITH uninterrupted views over the city, the Maribyrnong River and parklands, Horizon Drive has been aptly named.

ICG Property director Stephen Fergus said construction on the latest offering of 32 townhouses was due to start in June and finish at the end of next year.

“What sets us apart is that we have the most extraordinary views. We are on an elevated site which looks over the Maribyrnong River and the city skyline,” Mr Fergus said. “The views are totally uninterrupted and they will never be built out.”

Mr Fergus said the development had seven two-bedroom and two four-bedroom townhouses still on the market.

“They are designed by Rothe-lowman Architects and have European appliances, stone bench tops, as well as timber floors,” he said.

“There are carpets in the bedroom and double glazing to the front of the building.

“The two-bedroom townhouses come with two bathrooms and one car (space), and the four-bedrooms have two bathrooms and two car (spaces).”

Mr Fergus said the development was 8km from the city and within easy walking distance of Highpoint shopping centre.

“There are trams, buses and lots



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of facilities like shopping and cinemas in the area,” he said.

Prospective buyers can see the project's display from 4-6pm Thursdays and 2-4pm Saturdays and Sundays.
